*To All To Whom These Presents Shall Come:*


Pursuant to the power vested in me by Section 80 of the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, I, Ernie Fletcher, Governor, do issue this Proclamation convening the Kentucky General Assembly in Extraordinary Session at the Seat of Government, Frankfort, Kentucky, at 4:00 pm (EDT), Monday, August 20, 2007, for the sole purpose of considering the following subjects:

Advancing the Commonwealth's energy policy by creating economic development and educational incentives to encourage an increase in the production and use of alternative fuels and renewable energy resources, promoting energy conservation, environmental stewardship and increased energy efficiency in Kentucky, reorganizing energy related functions of the Executive Branch of the Commonwealth and increasing research on energy related issues for the purpose of decreasing the Commonwealth's and the nation's dependence on foreign sources of energy and making appropriations therefor and declaring an emergency.

The members of the General Assembly will, therefore, assemble in accordance with this Proclamation at the Seat of Government at Frankfort, Kentucky, in Extraordinary Session on the day and date above written, to act upon the subjects herein specified, and upon no other subjects.

DONE AT THE CAPITOL, in the city of Frankfort, on this the 17<sup>th</sup> day of August in the year of our Lord Two Thousand and Seven and in the year of the Commonwealth Two Hundred and Sixteen.
