


*To All To Whom These Presents Shall Come:*

Pursuant to the power vested in me by Section 80 of the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, I, Ernie Fletcher, Governor, do issue this Proclamation, amending my Proclamation dated June 21, 2006, all the terms of said Proclamation being hereby incorporated by reference herein, and I do further hereby add the following subjects to said Proclamation for consideration by the General Assembly of Kentucky in Extraordinary Session at the Seat of Government, Frankfort, Kentucky:

- (1) Enacting legislation to provide certain tax exemptions for coal-based near zero emission power plants that would have a net positive economic impact on the Commonwealth of Kentucky; and
- (2) Declaring an emergency thereby making any legislation enacted pursuant to this Proclamation effective upon the signature of the Governor.

The members of the General Assembly will, therefore, in accordance with this Proclamation and at the Seat of Government at Frankfort, Kentucky, in Extraordinary Session, act upon the subjects herein specified, and upon no other subjects.
