WRIT OF ELECTION

Seventy-Second District - House

WHEREAS, the Honorable Carolyn Belcher, Representative from the Seventy-Second House District, was duly elected Bath County Judge Executive on November 6, 2007, and was administered the oath of office as required by Section 228 of the Kentucky Constitution; and

WHEREAS, by letter dated November 13, 2007, the Honorable Carolyn Belcher resigned as State Representative and, as a result, a vacancy now exists in the House of Representatives, Seventy-Second Legislative District; and

WHEREAS, KRS 118.730 requires the Governor to issue a writ of election to fill a vacancy occurring in the House when the General Assembly is not in session:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Ernie Fletcher, Governor of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, pursuant to the authority vested in me by KRS 118.730, do hereby issue a writ of election to fill the vacancy in the Seventy-Second Legislative District, to be held on Tuesday, January 8, 2008, and hereby direct that this writ be forwarded to the Sheriffs of Bath, Bourbon, Fayette, and Nicholas Counties as required by KRS 118.730 and 118.740.
