To All To Whom These Presents Shall Come:

WHEREAS, by Proclamation dated July 2, 2007 and pursuant to the power vested in me by Section 80 of the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, I, Ernie Fletcher, Governor, did call upon the Kentucky General Assembly to convene in Extraordinary Session for the sole purpose of considering the subjects enumerated in that Proclamation;

WHEREAS, on July 5, 2007 the House of Representatives and Senate did convene in Extraordinary Session;

WHEREAS, on July 5, 2007 the House of Representatives, without considering any of the subjects enumerated in the Proclamation, passed HCR 1 in an attempt to adjourn *sine die* without concurrence of the Senate;

WHEREAS, from July 5, 2007 through July 9, 2007 the Senate considered all of the subjects enumerated in the Proclamation and, on July 9, 2007, passed them in their entirety as Senate Bills 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5;

WHEREAS, on July 9, 2007 the Senate ruled out of order HCR 1 by voice vote and communicated same to the Clerk of the House of Representatives;

WHEREAS, it has now been certified to me that there is a disagreement between the two chambers of the Kentucky General Assembly with respect to the time of adjournment of the Extraordinary Session;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 80 of the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Kentucky when the two chambers of the Kentucky General Assembly are in disagreement as to the time of adjournment of an Extraordinary Session, the Governor is authorized to adjourn the General Assembly to such time as he shall think proper.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the power vested in me by Section 80 of the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, I, Ernie Fletcher, do hereby temporarily adjourn the Extraordinary Session convened by the July 2, 2007 Proclamation and do further direct as follows:

1. That the General Assembly shall reassemble and reconvene this Extraordinary Session at the Seat of Government, Frankfort, Kentucky, at 4:00 p.m. (EDT), Monday, July 30, 2007; and
2. That the General Assembly shall act upon the subjects specified in the July 2, 2007 Proclamation, additionally consider legislation waiving any and all compensation, including expense allowances and standard stationary allowances, authorized for legislators under KRS 6.190, KRS 6.211, House Bill 381 (the current legislative budget) or any other applicable law for the duration of the adjournment declared herein, and upon no other subjects.
